The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) revokes the 501(c)(3) status from organizations with administrators who fail to file the appropriate **Form 990 Information Return** for three consecutive years. Nevertheless, the IRS allows nonprofit administrators to complete the application process and pay the fee to reinstate the 501(c)(3) status.
